Modeled after the Leadership Rhode Island (LRI) Core Program for business and community leaders, the College Leadership Rhode Island (CLRI) Program inspires, educates, and engages a diverse group of emerging young adult leaders (18-26 years old) as they transition from college to career.

CLRI is a tuition-free, academic-year-long program (September-May) that prepares students to navigate life after college and beyond. Through experiential learning, students can explore careers in the nonprofit, private, public, and philanthropic sectors in the first semester. The second semester of the program is focused on Well-Being: Physical, Financial, Career, Community and Social. The program provides students with the knowledge, skills, and networks necessary to develop their professional lives and build a future as engaged Rhode Island citizens.
